2. Under 'Applications,' type 'Remote Desktop' in the top right hand corner search area, then click on 'Remote Desktop Client for Windows Desktop (x64).' Click on 'Install.'



3. Once installed, refer to Attachment A and open '**Remote Desktop**,' log in using the same credentials as you would to sign onto your PC. (*you should only have to do this once*)

Note: You may have to click through a number of prompted questions.

4. Hover over '**CSE desktop**' and right click, then select '**Settings**.' This will pull up a sidebar menu to change the default options. Unselect '**Use default settings**' so that it shows '**Off**.' Under '**Display settings**,' select '**Single display**' from the '**Display configuration**' drop down. (*you should only have to do this once*)
