## DID YOU KNOW...



Storm drains do not drain to the sanitary sewer. Storm water does not get treated like waste water does.



Storm water is transported by storm drain systems and eventually flows in to streams, creeks, lakes, rivers, and the ocean.



Storm water picks up pollutants along its journey which can harm wildlife, disrupt recreational activities, and pollute drinking water sources.
