<p># 3</p>	<p>Submit an electronic Authorization to Release Information form by going to the “Student Records” section of your Student Center and selecting “Authorization to Release”.</p>			
<p># 4</p>	<p>Sign up for e-Refund (direct deposit) through your Student Center under the “Financials” section.</p>			
<p># 5</p>	<p>Use your Student Center for important information at Chico State.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Your financial aid and charges are located under the “Financials” section. ○ Check your To-Do list and holds. Follow the instructions. ○ If assigned on your To-Do list, create a financial aid account: http://csuchico.studentforms.com ○ Accept/decline/reduce your financial aid in order to receive your funds. ○ Review charges and pay the difference by the deadlines. <p>Financial aid recipients are required to pay the difference between all University charges and <i>pending</i> financial aid. You must accept aid for it to be “pending”. University charges may include tuition and campus fees, on-campus housing and meal plan. <p># 6</p>	<p>Educate yourself about loans and only borrow what you need!</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ✓ Know the difference: Financial aid includes loans and grants. Loans have to be repaid. Grants are free aid, and are determined by your SAI (Student Aid Index calculated from FAFSA or CADAA). ✓ If you are accepting loans as part of your financial aid package, you must complete both Loan Entrance Counseling and the Master Promissory Note. <p># 7</p>	<p>Learn about Scholarships.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Apply for Wildcat Scholarships: Chico State gives out \$1.6 million in scholarships each year. The online application is available January 2 through February 15 for the following academic year. www.csuchico.edu/fa/scholarships/wildcat.shtml • Apply for external (private) scholarships through community organizations, local and national foundations, state and federal agencies, fraternal organizations, and private donors. If you receive an external scholarship check, take it to Student Financial Services, SSC 230.
