October 1

Complete or renew your FAFSA or CADAA at:

<https://studentaid.gov/h/apply-for-aid/fafsa> or
<https://dream.csac.ca.gov/>. Use the IRS Data Retrieval Tool on the
FAFSA to use updated tax information. Net cash, savings and other
assets should be accurate as of the date the FAFSA or CADAA is
signed. You must reapply each year. **CSU, Chico's Federal School
Code is 001146.**

January 2 – February 15

Apply for **Wildcat Scholarships**. The online application is available at
www.csuchico.edu/fa/scholarships/wildcat.shtml for all University
scholarships to be awarded for the next academic year.
Deadline: February 15.

March 2

**This is the priority deadline for submitting a FAFSA or the
California Dream Act Application (CADAA) for CSU, Chico.** Your
application must be submitted by this date in order for consideration for
all available funds. Be sure to provide an email address on the FAFSA
or CADAA in order to receive timely award information.

**March 2 is also the deadline to file the FAFSA or CADAA for the
Middle Class Scholarship and Cal Grant eligibility as well as the
GPA verification deadline.** Students who are new to CSU, Chico or
have fewer than 24 college units, must contact their previous school
(high school or former college) to have GPA verification sent to CSAC.

Beginning in March

The Financial Aid and Scholarship Office sends notification of an **initial
award offer** via email to newly admitted students for whom we
have received an official FAFSA or CADAA. Students can view their
offer online by accessing their Student Center via the CSU, Chico
portal. The email is **your award letter** and includes complete
instructions. If required on your To-Do List, create a Financial Aid
Account and complete all tasks at: <https://csuchico.verifymyfafsa.com>.

Loan borrowers: First-time student loan borrowers at CSU, Chico
must complete Loan Entrance Counseling and a Master Promissory
Note (MPN) before the first loan disbursement. First-time parent PLUS
loan borrowers must also complete an MPN before the first loan
disbursement. Visit <https://studentaid.gov/mpn/parentplus/landing>
to complete these requirements.

Summer Financial Aid: Students who enroll in summer courses
will automatically be considered for financial aid if they have completed
a 2021/22 FAFSA or CADAA. Enroll in summer courses early, summer
aid may be limited.

June 1

**Upload all requested documents on your Student Center To-Do
List by June 1** to receive your aid by the first disbursement in
August. **If you submit your documents after this date, your fall
disbursement could be in September or later.**

July - August

Check your CSU, Chico Student Center weekly for updates, To Do List
items, and hold information. All requirements must be cleared before
your financial aid will be disbursed. Watch for emails from us.

The Thursday prior to the first day of classes is the first possible
disbursement of financial aid and scholarships each semester.

Ongoing - Search for private scholarships.
