



Estimated Standard Full-Time Undergraduate Budget 2022/2023

Each college calculates its own student budget, also known as **Cost of Attendance**. At Chico State the student budget is based on the **estimated cost** of a typical student's registration and tuition fees, books and supplies, room and board, transportation, and personal expenses for a nine-month academic year (fall and spring semesters). Your actual budget will vary depending on where you live (on or off campus or with your parents) and on your discretionary spending.

Undergraduate budgets reflect estimated tuition fees based on full-time enrollment. Other costs are averaged. Students who live on campus are responsible for the room and board rates in their License Agreement. The above Room/Board figure is an averaged estimate.

- * Budgets are for a **nine-month academic year**. They include **direct university charges** (tuition/fees and on-campus room and board) and **discretionary expenses** (transportation, books, supplies, personal expenses, and off-campus room and board). Note: On-campus room and board is contracted for the entire 9-month period. Also note: Loan origination fees may be added if loans are accepted.
- ** Note all CSU listed tuition fees should be regarded as **estimates** that are subject to change upon approval by the CSU Board of Trustees. **Non-resident** students add an additional \$396 per unit to regular tuition fees. **Western University Exchange (WUE)** students pay 150 percent of the State University Tuition Fee and 100 percent of the campus fees.
- *** Students may request a budget transportation increase if they commute to Chico from outside the city or travel to off-site locations for course credit required for their degree.
