Classification	Duties	Job Code
ISA	Undergraduate or graduate student: Teaching, grading, or tutoring for the majority of work hours. May also include grading examinations, recording grades, etc.	1150/1151
GA	Graduate student: Assists faculty with non-teaching assistance in subject or program doing graduate work. Duties may include supervising students in a classroom, workshop, or lab (taught by faculty), training students in the use of equipment; conducting research by collecting and arranging data and preparation of course materials; evaluating students' work; tutoring students, and other related work.	2355
TA	Graduate student: Practical teaching experience in fields related to their advanced study. Duties primarily involve classroom and laboratory instruction. Provides classroom and/or lab instruction, making assignments, preparing course materials, administering exams, assessing student performance, tutoring students, and determining course grades. Assist faculty with field experience, supervision, simulation exercises, and/or research projects.	2354
SA	Duties ranging from unskilled to skilled and/or specialized in a variety of positions with limited use of discretion and judgment. Specific job duties are defined by the appropriate campus department. May include clerical, analytical, or advising. Does not perform academic related duties such as instruction, tutoring, grading, evaluating, research, and assisting faculty with classroom activities.	1870
