Nursing Units: 20 Nursing Units, over and above the 70 transferable units, will be used as NCLEX credit at Chico State and are issued in the final semester of the RN to BSN Program. Additional Nursing Units, up to 16, may be used as part of the 70 transferable units. Butte's ADN program has 51 transferable nursing units and the LVN to RN Program has 46-79 transferable nursing units; 36 are allowed to be used. 54 other CSU transferable units are needed.

* Area F will be required for all Chico State students starting Fall 2023 unless they have been continuously enrolled prior to Fall 2021 and have catalog rights of Fall 2020 or earlier. The RN-BSN program will continue to evaluate prospective students and admits case by case. Approved courses can be taken at other California Community Colleges or at the CSU after transfer.
