Additional Nursing Units, up to 16, may be used as part of the 70 transferable units. COR's ADN RN program has 38 transferable nursing units; 36 are used. 54 other CSU transferable units are needed. COR's LVN/Paramedic to RN option has 22 transferable nursing units. 68 other CSU transferable units are needed.</p>			
<p>* Area F will be required for all Chico State students starting Fall 2023 unless they have been continuously enrolled prior to Fall 2021 and have catalog rights of Fall 2020 or earlier. The RN-BSN program will continue to evaluate prospective students and admits case by case. Approved courses can be taken at other California Community Colleges or at the CSU after transfer.
