CSUC RN to BSN Program requires 20 transferrable Nursing Units, over and above 70 transferrable Community College units, to give as NCLEX Credit of 20 units during the final semester of the RN to BSN Program. Any transferrable Nursing Units in excess of 20 (up to 16 units), may count towards the 70 units allowed to transfer from a Community College.

Strongly suggest seeing your Academic Counselor each semester.

Prerequisites:

1. Must be eligible for admission to the University.
2. Eligibility for admission to the RN to BSN Nursing major:
 - Graduation from an associate degree program in nursing (can be in final semester).
 - 54 transferrable non-nursing units (GE certification courses, Nursing prerequisites & co-requisites).
 - Completion of CSU, Chico lower division GE requirements.
 - Completion of all CSU, Chico Nursing prerequisite courses (Anatomy, Physiology, Microbiology, Chemistry, Oral Communication, Written Communication, Critical Thinking, & Statistics) with minimum "C" grade.
 - Cumulative GPA of 3.0 (will accept most recent 60 units); 3.0 in Nursing is required to apply before graduation
 - Must be accepted into the RN to BSN Program by the School of Nursing before applying to CSU, Chico.
