Additional Nursing Units, up to 16, can be used as part of the 70 transferrable units. Yuba AD RN program has 49.5+ transferrable nursing units; 36 are used. 54 other CSU transferrable units are needed. Yuba LVN to RN students have 25-30 or more transferrable nursing units. They may need a total of 65 other CSU transferrable units to qualify for the CSUC RN To BSN Program, unless they have transferrable LVN units.</p>
