Upper Division GE Requirements Waived for Post Baccalaureate Students

Nursing Units: 20 Nursing Units, over and above the 70 transferable units, are needed to be used as NCLEX credit at Chico State and are issued in the final semester of the RN to BSN Program. Additional Nursing Units, up to 16, can be used as part of the 70 transferable units. Yuba AD RN program has 49.5+ transferable nursing units; 36 are used. 54 other CSU transferable units are needed. Yuba LVN to RN students have 25-30 or more transferable nursing units. They may need a total of 65 other CSU transferable units to qualify for the Chico State RN to BSN Program, unless they have transferable LVN units.

* Area F will be required for all Chico State students starting Fall 2023 unless they have been continuously enrolled prior to Fall 2021 and have catalog rights of Fall 2020 or earlier. The RN-BSN program will continue to evaluate prospective students and admits case by case. Approved courses can be taken at other California Community Colleges. Please see a counselor/advisor for more information.
