Dosage Calculation Exam

All 3rd semester students must verify competency in the safe administration of medications before they are eligible to administer medications during hospital clinical experiences OB/Peds and Medical-Surgical. The proctored Semester 3 Dosage Calculation Assessment will be administered on **Friday, August 30, 2024, at 1500** during the **ALL SECTIONS NURS314 Orientation**. Students **CANNOT** administer medication in clinic settings unless they pass the Dosage Calculation Exam with $\geq 90\%$. If students score below a 90%, they will be expected to repeat the dosage exam until a $\geq 90\%$ is achieved. A re-take is usually scheduled 1-2 weeks after the original dosage exam and will be scheduled and administered by your clinical instructor.

Semester 3 Medical-Surgical Nursing Information

NURS343 Medical-Surgical Nursing II (Lecture)

This course is a 3-unit continuation of NURS302. It is primarily pathophysiology and care of the adult with medical disorders not covered in NURS302. The course meets from 0800-1100 every Wednesday in Holt Hall 363, and the first meeting will be **Wednesday, August 28, 2024**. The syllabus, course calendar, and other information will be published in Canvas before the semester begins. Textbooks will be the same as those for NURS302.

NURS344 Medical-Surgical Nursing II Clinical

This is a 90-hour clinical practicum that meets on Mondays at various clinical host facilities. The course includes two simulation experiences (3 hours each) at the **Northern California Rural SimCenter, located at 560 Cohasset Rd. Chico, CA**, and two Skills Labs (3 hours each – locations TBA), also scheduled on Mondays. The first Simulation/Skills day will be the first day of the semester, **Monday, August 26, 2024**. The second Simulation/Skills day will be Monday, **November 18, 2024**. NURS344 faculty will provide you with times for your section prior to the beginning of the semester.

Section 1 – Enloe Medical Center, Chico, CA – Various units. 8 hours each Monday for a total of 80 hours (10 clinical days). Faculty will provide students with actual dates of attendance. A mandatory facility orientation will be on **Tuesday, August 27, 2024**, at the Enloe Conference Center. In-hospital clinical experience begins on **Monday, September 9, 2024**. Also, see Note below. Register for this section if you completed NURS304 at Enloe in Fall 2023.

Section 2 – Enloe Medical Center, Chico, CA – Various units. 8 hours each Monday for a total of 80 hours (10 clinical days). Faculty will provide students with actual dates of attendance. A mandatory facility orientation will be on **Tuesday, August 27, 2024**, at the Enloe Conference Center. In-hospital clinical experience begins on **Monday, September 9, 2024**. Also, see Note below. Register for this section if you completed NURS304 at Enloe in Fall 2023.

Section 4 – Adventist Health + Rideout, Marysville, CA – Variable units. 12 and/or 8 hours each Monday for a total of 80 hours (variable number of clinical days). Orientation will be at the Adventist Health + Rideout Education Center in Yuba City, CA, date TBA. This will be the first 12-hour day, and you will start clinical hours in the hospital following orientation. Register for this section if you completed NURS304 at Adventist Health + Rideout in Fall 2023.
