

Time, Place, and Manner of Expression Policy

This policy applies to students, student organizations, campus-affiliated organizations, faculty and staff, and off-campus groups or persons while on campus grounds, including commercial vendors or solicitors.

Time

Indoor Events: No fixed time constraints, but most University buildings are not available between the hours of 11PM and 7AM Outdoor Events with Amplified Sound: If the event includes amplified music or speech, it may be held Sunday through Thursday, 7AM to 11PM.

Outdoor Events without Amplified Sound: Outdoor events and activies that do not require amplified sound may be held anytime, Monday through Sunday.

Generally, Trinity Commons is the most common place where individuals/groups assemble. Other locations on campus can be used for free speech activities, with the exception of University Residential Areas and the BMU/WREC unless permission has been granted by them directly.





Regardless of time or place, expressive activity on campus must be conducted consistent with the general limitations outlined in Section IV, in addition to guidelines that are specific to the venues.
