Manipulate and create your own semester by semester plan using your Smart Planner in your Portal. Review your Degree Progress Report (DPR) in your Student Center, meet with your Major Department Advisor for major coursework, and meet with an Academic Advisor in SSC 220 to review General Education and Graduation requirements. University Writing Requirement: You must complete a GE Written Communication (A2) course with a grade of C- or higher, and a Graduation Writing Assessment Requirement (GW) course in your major with a grade of C- or higher. In addition you must complete 2 additional Writing (W) courses, see your DPR for specific writing course options. Consider meeting the United States Diversity and Global Cultures requirements within GE courses. Apply to graduate one year before anticipated graduation date. Priority registration is guaranteed your final semester if you applied for graduation by the stated deadline.
