A California Studies minor has been part of other Social Science and Special Programs curricula for a number of years. The Curriculum Advisory Board (CAB) representing General Education (GE) requested the use of the name "California Studies" for a new GE pathway. The Social Science program agreed to this change with a willingness to adopt to the name originally proposed for the new pathway "California: People, Places, and Cultures."
