



Required Medical Records

Please review the following requirements to make sure your records are compliant with the RCNP requirements. Please note that a valid record is one from the agency where you received the vaccine or test, OR one that has been officially transcribed from another health care agency. In addition, please be sure you are sending legible copies of all vaccines and tests.

VACCINE/TEST	REQUIRED RECORDS
Measles, Mumps, & Rubella (MMR)	 Must show record of a positive blood titer for Measles, Mumps, & Rubella OR Record of 2-shot series
Hepatitis B	 Must show record of a titer AND Record of 3-shot series Hep B records are not required to be submitted with the RCNP application, but will be collected later prior to preceptorship start date. Do not procrastinate getting your titer.
TdaP	 Must have received one dose at 19 years of age or older. (Afterward, Td rather than Tdap.) Must have received last dose (Td or Tdap) in the last 10 years.
Varicella (Chicken Pox)	 Must show record of a positive blood titer for Varicella OR Record of 2-shot series
Influenza (Flu)	Must have 1 dose of current year's vaccination or a signed declination form for placements occurring during flu season. Flu vaccine records are not required to be submitted with the RCNP application, but will be collected later if placement occurs during flu season.
TB Testing	Please do not provide TB records with application. (Accepted applicants will be required to provide evidence of negative TB status prior to preceptorship start dates. Specific instructions to follow.)
