

# Proposed Student Fee Adjustment Fall 2018



## Background

The University is engaging the campus community to inform students about proposed fee adjustments to the Health Services Fee, Athletics Fee, and the Student Learning Fee. Campus-based student fees provide the base funding for these important programs that prepare our students for success, support student well-being, enhance the college experience and build campus pride. These fees have not been adjusted, besides slight inflationary increases, in over 15 years.

## Proposal

At the current funding levels in these programs, students are experiencing the following impacts.

- Long wait times, not enough appointments, not enough medical providers and counselors
- Outdated equipment and hardware in classrooms and labs, limited support services such as tutoring
- Not enough funding to sustain a competitive athletics program

This proposal seeks to address the above negative experiences and continue to improve services provided to our students.
