This year's Civic Expo will take place on December 5th, 2024, from 3 pm - 5 pm in Colusa 100.



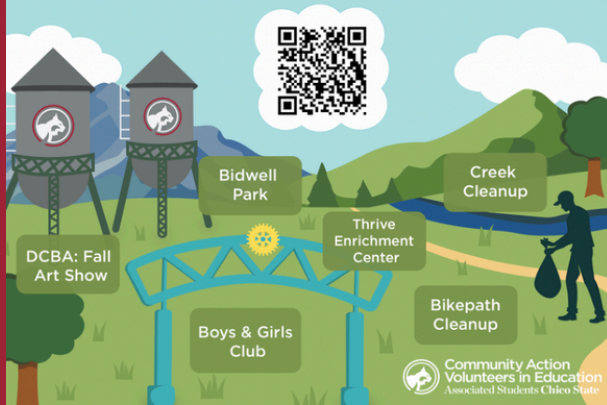

Revenue Sharing

- Revenue sharing is a program that allows students to allocate \$15 towards student organizations during the AS General Election.
- To receive a revenue sharing reimbursement, a student organization must be recognized and in good standing.

Funds can be used on food, decor, supplies for club meetings, conference fees, club apparel, and more!

Funds cannot be used on alcohol, tobacco, firearms, gift cards, plastic bottles, styrofoam, cannabis, etc.
