

CORE Rubric Supervision Process

1. Supervisors take notes on Observation Record, Part I.
2. After the observation, use your notes and the CORE Rubric to debrief the observation with the candidate.
3. Using the CORE rubric for reference, record a score for each of the 4 areas and a statement of evidence supporting that score on the Observation Record, Part II.
4. Record co-teaching feedback on Part III.
5. Write an observation summary on Part IV.
6. At the end of each practicum, complete the final evaluation form, with average scores from the semester. Submit paper form as part of the supervision packet. Submit scores to STEPS, using the link on the final evaluation form.
