Don't see your major listed above? Don't panic!

Universities listed as **"Full Curriculum Studies"** allow student to enroll directly in the host university (most majors are available in multiple locations).

GE Pathway students may earn up to **18 units** abroad toward their GE Pathway, including 2 or even all 3 upper division pathway (Humanities, Social Science & Natural Science) requirements.

Communications & Journalism majors should work toward their required minor abroad. Choose a minor offered where you want to go!

Construction Management majors are encouraged to take their upper division GE Pathway requirements or elective business courses abroad.

International Relations majors should definitely study abroad and can fulfill language requirements or take entire "Non IR Electives" (9 units) abroad in *many* locations.

Liberal Studies majors can take entire area of concentration abroad (12 units) on any program they choose.

Child Development majors can take entire depth core abroad (9 units) on any program they choose. Minors will need to see their academic advisor for substitutions.

Language majors and minors are offered in many locations around the world, and fluency is an added bonus! Definitely worth considering.

Pre-Nursing majors are encouraged to declare a foreign language minor or work on their GE Pathway requirements abroad before acceptance into the Nursing Program.
