Through generous donations to CSU, Chico, International Education and Global Engagement (IEGE) is able offer financial awards to well-qualified CSU, Chico students participating in approved Study Abroad programs or students who are studying outside their home country to attend the University on an F-1 visa.

The two primary purposes of the award are to promote and develop intercultural competency as well as lower financial barriers students may face to achieve their educational goals away from home. The minimum award amount is \$1,500

AWARD CRITERIA

- Pursuit of a bachelor's or master's degree at CSU, Chico
- Full-time enrollment at CSU, Chico or at a CSU, Chico approved Study Abroad program.
- 2.5 or higher cumulative GPA
- Submission of a complete application and all supporting documents by the application deadline

3. Obtain a Letter of Recommendation
4. Print a current Financial Aid Award Letter (if a recipient of US government or California aid)
