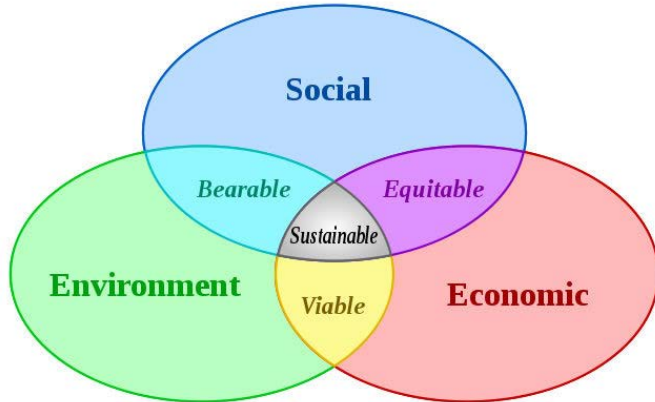


Stewards of Sustainability

What is Sustainability?



“**Sustainability** is the process of maintaining change in a balanced environment, in which the exploitation of resources, the direction of investments, the orientation of technological development and institutional change are all in harmony and enhance both current and future potential to meet human needs and aspirations.”

Sustainability is often defined with the three categories, social: has to be fair and ethical for the people, economic: has to have a positive impact on our economy, and lastly environment: cannot harm our ecosystem. All these are crucial for developing a world in which future generations and species can live.

Stewards of Sustainability

Check off each task to become Steward:

- Visit the Compost Display Area** – volunteer or drop off compost from home (6pts).
- Attend a Farmer's Market** – Wed morning, Thurs Night or Sat morning in Chico. If you don't live in Chico, see if there is one near you (7pts).
- Take a ride on the B-Line** – The B-line is payed for by your student tuition so take advantage of a resource you already payed for (7pts).
- Vote** – in your local, state, or federal elections (6pts).
- Go to Upper Bidwell Park** – take a hike and enjoy the beauty of Upper Bidwell Park (7pts).
- Bring a Friend** – Bring a friend to any sustainability related event (6pts).
- Attend a Social Justice Event** – attend an event hosted by the Cross Cultural Leadership Center, Community Legal Information Center, Multi-Cultural Affairs, or any other event related to Social Justice (7pts).
- Educate another on Sustainability** – Teach someone you know about one topic related to sustainability (6pts).
- Go to BCCER** – Big Chico Creek Ecological Reserve (BCCER) encompass over 3,500 acres of diverse habitats and wildlife. Take a walk and see what Chico's wildlife is all about (7pts)!

- Participate in a Creek Clean up** – Attend a monthly creek clean up or go out on your own time and pick up trash. Look for dates on student announcements (7pts).
- Visit Chico State's Farm** – Check out the Farm's Organic Vegetable Project or meat lab for local produce and protein (7pts).
- Attend a Student Government Meeting** – Attend any Associated Students meeting: Business Council, Bell Memorial Union Council, Board of Directors, Sustainability Affairs Council, Government Affairs Council, Legislative Affairs Council, Multi-Cultural Affairs Council, or the Sustainability Fund Allocation Committee. Check with SLL (BMU 220) when times are (6pts).
- Sustainability Day** – Attend the Campus Sustainability Day Festival on Oct 23, 10:00-2:00 in the Trinity Commons (7pts).
- Volunteer** – for at least one hour at a non-profit of your choice... there are many to choose from depending on what you are most interested in (7pts)!
