To become a Social Work Major and to begin Professional Sequence Courses, students must submit a BSW DL Professional Sequence Application. This is a competitive application process. You are able to apply if:

\* You have a qualifying cumulative GPA (grade point average) of 2.0, and

\* You have passed the 2 Social Work Prerequisite Courses by the end of Fall semester, with a grade C or better, and

\* You have passed the 3 Social Work Prerequisite Core Courses by the end of Fall semester with a grade C or better

\* Ability to attend two face-to-face, on campus weekends per semester at CSUC.

\* Ability to do internship within the service region during your senior year (uppermost 18 counties in California).

The BSW Professional Sequence Application process opens August 1<sup>st</sup>, and closes September 15<sup>th</sup> to start the following Spring. Applicants will be informed of admission decisions mid-November. Please visit our website for all other application information.
