You are able to apply if:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> * You have a qualifying cumulative GPA (grade point average) of 2.0, and * You have passed the 5 Social Work Prerequisite Courses by the end of Fall semester, with a grade C or better, and * You have passed the 3 Social Work Prerequisite Core Courses by the end of Fall semester with a grade C or better * Ability to attend two face-to-face, on campus weekends per semester at CSUC. * Ability to do internship within the service region during your senior year (uppermost 18 counties in California). <p>The BSW Professional Sequence Application process opens August 1st, and closes September 15th to start the following Spring.
