(O) = Fully online, asynchronous (H) = Hybrid – a combination of asynchronous and synchronous. Hybrid courses require attendance to scheduled class time via Zoom and class attendance during two weekends on-campus, face-to-face each semester (Spring, Summer, Fall). (F) = Field Placement (W) = Fulfills GE writing requirement *Only ONE Social Work Elective is required and can be taken in either the fall or spring semester. There are options listed for each focus area: (1) Families, Children and Youth Services, (2) Gerontology, and (3) Mental Health.

ADDITIONAL PROGRAM DETAILS:

- Students MUST **apply to the SWRK BSW Professional Sequence** in the fall semester. To apply, [visit the SWRK website](#).
- Applicants who are already attending or planning to transfer to CSU Chico must complete a minimum of 60 transferable semester units (90 quarter units) by summer preceding applicant's junior year is required. The 60 units must include all eight Social Work pre-requisites, with a minimum of C grade, and the "Golden Four" (A1, A2, A3, A4/B4). Human Biology, Economics, Statistics, Intro Psychology, Intro Sociology, and the Social Work Core Courses SWRK 170, SWRK 200, and SWRK 202 must be completed or in progress at time of Professional Sequence Application. All BSW students must pass prerequisites with a "C grade" or higher to start the BSW Professional Sequence. - One Social Work Elective is required for graduation—choose from SWRK 320, 474, 478, or 481.
