

**Prerequisites to the California State University (CSU), Chico Bachelor of Arts in Social Work (BSW)
Fall 2024**

This table lists the prerequisite courses for entering the BSW Professional Sequence of the Social Work program at CSU Chico. All courses listed under your respective community college are equivalent to the courses on the left hand column under CSU, Chico. All prerequisites must be completed with a minimum grade of “C” or higher. As of Fall 2024, applicants must complete PSYC, SOCI, as well as SWRK 170, SWRK 200, and SWRK 202, which must be completed by DECEMBER of the applicant’s junior year.

In addition to completing the prerequisites below, to enter the professional sequence, applicants must have a minimum cumulative 2.0 GPA for the traditional BSW program and the BSW Distance Learning (DL) program. All applicants must submit a BSW Professional Sequence [application](#) between August 1st and September 15th of their junior year and complete a minimum of 60 hours of employment, volunteer, or service-learning hours in a social service setting/support role prior to starting the BSW Professional Sequence.
