The School of Social Work within the College of Behavioral & Social Science at Chico State invites expressions of interest in part-time teaching. Part-time teaching opportunities are available throughout the academic year. We keep all qualified applications on file and review them as needed. In addition, we contact all qualified candidates in our pool annually to verify their continued interest in being considered.

Qualifications

For almost all of our courses a minimum of a Masters of Social Work degree is required. A PhD is preferred. For some courses, an exception may be made for someone who possesses a degree in a related/relevant field. In addition, candidates must have a minimum of two years post-MSW degree social work professional experience. Experience teaching is a plus.

Compensation

The average starting salary for a lecturer is \$4,398/full time equivalent (FTE). A 3 unit course with a .20 time base. $4,398 * .20 = 879/\text{month gross salary} \times 6 \text{ months} = 5,274 \text{ total}$.
