KNOW YOUR OPTIONS, RIGHTS AND REMEDIES:

The University encourages victims of Sexual Violence to talk to someone about what happened—so you can get the support you need, and so the University can respond appropriately.

If you have experienced Sexual Violence we encourage you to speak with the campus Title IX Coordinator

to ensure your physical safety, emotional support and medical care.

The University's primary concern is the safety of its campus community members. Victims should not be deterred from reporting incidents of Sexual Violence out of a concern that they might be disciplined for related

violations of drug, alcohol or other University policies.

The University will not require you to participate in any investigation or disciplinary proceeding if you do not wish to participate. However, the university may be required to conduct an investigation.
